



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 28**  
Series of 2025

**REORGANIZATION OF THE MUNICIPAL  
WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, Presidential Decree No. 1152, also known as the Philippine Environmental Code (1977), establishes specific environmental management policies and prescribes environmental quality standards for air and water, land use management, natural resource management and conservation, as well as enforcement and waste management guidelines. Section 23 of the same decree specifically stipulates that "all provinces, cities, and municipalities shall be mandated to prepare and implement waste management programs."

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 8749 or known as the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999 declares a comprehensive air quality management policy and program which aims to achieve and maintain healthy air for all Filipinos and provides for the creation of a national program of air pollution management focusing primarily on pollution prevention; for the promotion of mass media communication in order to create social awareness and active participation in air quality planning and monitoring;

**WHEREAS**, Section 36 of RA No. 8749 mandates the role of Local Government Units who shall share the responsibility in the management and maintenance of air quality within their territorial jurisdiction, and consistent with Sections 7, 8 and 9 thereof, by implementing air quality standards set by the Board in areas within their jurisdiction with DENR's technical assistance, trainings and a continuing capability-building program to prepare them to undertake full administration of the air quality management and regulation within their territorial jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9003 or known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 declares the policy of the state in adopting a systematic, comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program that ensures the protection of public health and the environment and the proper segregation, collection, transport, storage, treatment and disposal of solid waste through the formulation and adoption of best environmental practices;

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 10 of Republic Act No. 9003 defines the role of local government units (LGUs) in solid waste management pursuant to the relevant provisions of R.A. No. 7160, as they shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of the said Act within their respective jurisdictions wherein segregation and collection of solid waste shall be conducted at the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes and provided, that the collection of non-recyclable materials and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the municipality or city.

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9275 or known as the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004 aims to **protect the country's water bodies from pollution from land-based sources** (industries and commercial establishments, agriculture and community/household activities) and promotes environmental strategies, use of appropriate economic instruments and of control mechanisms for the protection and abatement of pollution of the country's water resources;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of RA 9275 specifically provides for National Sewerage and Septage Management Program that shall include a priority listing of sewerage, septage and combined

sewerage-septage projects for LGUs, programs/projects for the rehabilitation of existing facilities and such other factors that the Secretary (DENR) may deem relevant to the protection of water quality;

**WHEREAS**, LGUs may raise funds to subsidize necessary expenses for the operation and maintenance of waste management programs and implementation of waste management policies through local property taxes and enforcement of a service fee system;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Concepcion, Province of Tarlac created the Municipal Solid Waste Management (MSWM) Board, Ecological Solid Waste Management – Technical Working Group pursuant to Section 12 of RA 9003, which was later reorganized into the Municipal Waste Management Board, in order to effectively implement waste management policies and fully accomplish environmental quality standards for air and water, towards an ecologically balanced environment for the Municipality and its people;

**WHEREAS**, to strengthen the membership of the said Board,

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, NOEL L. VILLANUEVA**, Municipal Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reorganization of the Municipal Waste Management Board, to wit:

**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION**

**SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

***Ecological Waste Management***

1. Develop the Municipal Waste Management Plan that shall ensure the long-term management of ecological waste, as well as integrate the various waste management plan and strategies of the barangays in its jurisdiction. In the development of the Waste Management Plan, it shall conduct consultations with the various sectors of the community;
2. Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of waste management programs in its component barangays;
3. Monitor the implementation of the Municipal Waste Management Plan through its various political subdivisions and in cooperation with the private sectors and the civil society organizations;
4. Adopt specific revenue-generating measures to promote the viability of its Waste Management Plan;
5. Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the Waste Management Plan of the respective component barangays;
6. Oversee the implementation of the Municipal Waste Management Plan;
7. Review every two (2) years or as the need arises the Municipal Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuring the sustainability, viability, effectiveness, and relevance in relation to local and international developments in the field of waste management;
8. Develop the specific mechanics and guidelines for the implementation of the Municipal Waste Management Plan;
9. Recommend to appropriate local government authorities specific measures or proposals for franchise or build-operate-transfer agreement with duly recognized institutions, pursuant to Republic Act 6957, to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling, or disposal of municipal solid waste. The proposal shall take into consideration appropriate government rules and regulations on contracts, franchises, and build-operate-transfer agreements;
10. Provide the necessary logistical and operational support to its component cities and municipalities in consonance with a subsection of Section 17 of the Local Government Code;
11. Recommend measures and safeguards against pollution and for the preservation of the natural ecosystem;
12. Take active participation in all efforts concerning water quality protection and rehabilitation;
13. Coordinate with other government agencies and civil society and the concerned sectors in the implementation of measures to prevent and control water pollution; and
14. Coordinate the efforts of its component barangays in the implementation of the Municipal Waste Management Plan.

1. To prepare comprehensive air quality management programs, plans and strategies within the limits set forth in Republic Act No. 7160 and this Act which shall be implemented within the municipality's territorial jurisdiction upon the approval of the sanggunian;
2. To provide technical assistance and support to the governor or mayor, as the case may be, in carrying out measures to ensure the delivery of basic services and the provision of adequate facilities relative to air quality;
3. To take the lead in all efforts concerning air quality protection and rehabilitation;
4. To recommend air quality standards which shall not exceed the maximum permissible standards set by national laws
5. To coordinate with other government agencies and non-governmental organizations in the implementation of measures to prevent and control air pollution; and
6. Exercise such other powers and perform such duties and functions as may be prescribed by law or ordinance;

***Water Pollution Management***

1. To recommend or formulate policies that will ensure the monitoring of water quality within the municipality's territorial jurisdiction and compliance with the framework of the Water Quality Management Action Plan;
2. To take active participation in all efforts concerning water quality protection and rehabilitation; and
3. To coordinate with other government agencies and civil society and the concerned sectors in the implementation of measures to prevent and control water pollution;

**SECTION 3. COMPENSATION AND RENUMERATION**

All government officials and/or employees comprising the Municipal Waste Management Board (MWMB), shall, in addition to their regular duties, perform their duties directed as such in this Order without compensation or remuneration. Those who are not government officials or employees are entitled to necessary travelling expenses and allowances chargeable against the funds of the Municipal Waste Management Board, if available, and subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE**

All orders, issuances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof.

Let copies hereof be furnished all offices and personnel concerned, for their information and reference.
