



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 35

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE CONCEPCION-LAPAZ ROAD, CONCEPCION, TARLAC FOR TRUCKS PASSING THROUGH CONCEPCION, TARLAC, FROM 6:00 A.M. OF OCTOBER 31, 2025 TO 11:59 P.M. OF NOVEMBER 1, 2025, IN OBSERVANCE OF ALL SAINTS' DAY (UNDAS)

WHEREAS, it has been observed that traffic builds up in major thoroughfares traversing cemeteries and nearby premises prior to and during the observance of All Saints' Day (UNDAS);

WHEREAS, after the coordination meeting for "OPLAN UNDAS 2026" among members of the the Concepcion Municipal Police Station, Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, Traffic Enforcer Concepcion, and partner volunteer organizations, it was recommended to Municipal Mayor Noel L. Villanueva, that a truck ban be implemented from 6:00 a.m. of October 31, 2025 to 11:59 p.m. of November 1, 2025 along Concepcion-Lapaz Road from Barangay Santiago to Barangay Caluluan, Concepcion, Tarlac;

WHEREAS, Section 21 (c) of R.A. 7160 vests upon the Chief Local Executive the power to issue directives pertinent to the duration of temporary closure of national or local road, alley, park or square during an actual emergency, fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural and industrial fairs, or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications and waterworks projects, and to act immediately in the interest of public welfare;

WHEREAS, Undas or All Saints' Day is considered a significant public observance, similar to a "fiesta celebration," which justifies the temporary closure of a road to ensure public welfare during the event;

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to order the temporary closure of the Concepcion-Lapaz Road for the implementation of the truck ban on the specific time and dates recommended in order to ensure smooth traffic flow, maintain public safety and provide unhampered access for emergency response vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE, I, NOEL L. VILLANUEVA, Municipal Mayor of Concepcion, Tarlac, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

1. Temporary closure of the Concepcion-Lapaz Road from Barangay Santiago to Barangay Caluluan, Concepcion, Tarlac from 6:00 a.m. of October 31, 2025 up to 11:59 p.m. of November 1, 2025, for 6-wheeler and above trucks passing through Concepcion, Tarlac;
2. Restricted access to the Concepcion-Lapaz Road from Barangay Santiago to Barangay San Nicolas Poblacion, Concepcion, Tarlac from 6:00 a.m. of October 31, 2025 up to 11:59 p.m. of November 1, 2025 for trucks with businesses or deliveries in Concepcion. However, they can use the alternate route of San Jose-Sta. Rita-San Francisco thru Parua River Control or vice-versa;

3. The truck ban shall not cover ambulances, firetrucks, patient transport vehicles, public utility vehicles, and other passenger vehicles;
4. The sides/right of ways of Concepcion-Lapaz Road fronting the Concepcion Public Cemetery and Concepcion Shrine Memorial Park must be free from any obstruction, including vendors' stalls, for the public's safety and convenience;
5. The Philippine National Police-Concepcion Police Station, in coordination with other concerned agencies, is hereby directed to make the efficient implementation of the temporary closure of Concepcion-Lapaz Road/truck ban;
6. The temporary closure of the Concepcion-Lapaz Road/truck ban on the specified time and dates as indicated in this Executive Order shall be disseminated through all forms of media and signage necessary to inform the public.

All local orders, directives and issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are repealed and modified accordingly.
