



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 46**

**RE-ORGANIZATION OF THE MUNICIPAL DISASTER  
RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act 10121 mandates that there shall be a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) established in every municipality;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 8 Series of 2021 provided for the reorganization of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) of this Municipality pursuant to RA 10121;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to reorganize the composition of the MDRRMC of Concepcion, Tarlac to replace and include other members in order to effectively implement the disaster risk reduction and management programs of the National Government and its agencies;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the recent changes in leadership in various government offices and agencies, due to elections, appointments, or organizational adjustments, it is necessary to update the composition of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) to ensure proper representation and effective coordination;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, NOEL L. VILLANUEVA**, Municipal Mayor of Concepcion, Tarlac, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the MDRRMC of the Municipality of Concepcion, Tarlac, to wit:

**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.**

In accordance to Section 11 of the Republic Act 10121, the Incident Management Team shall have the following powers and duties:


1. Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Plan and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
2. Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
3. Recommend the implementation of forced or preemptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary; and
4. Convene the local council once every three (3) months or as necessary.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY.**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately, and shall revoke or amend accordingly all orders, issuances, or memorandum inconsistent herewith.

Let copies of this Order be furnished to offices and agencies concerned for their information and guidance.
